Description

Food safety experts from government, industry, and academia will gather in Madison, Wisconsin on May 14 and 15 for the annual Food Research Institute Spring Meeting at the University of Wisconsin-Madison. Throughout its history, the Institute has helped the food industry identify and solve food safety issues. Its focus on food microbiology and toxicology involves effective partnerships with industry and government. This year's presentations will also be offered virtually via Zoom.

The hybrid program will include presentations on artificial intelligence and food safety, natural and traditional antimicrobials, current toxicological concerns, basic research of foodborne pathogens, applied food microbiology in manufacturing, and more. This meeting features scientists from the University of Wisconsin-Madison and other universities as well as industry and government.

Don Schaffner from Rutgers University will present the William C. Frazier Memorial lecture and will be recognized for his contributions to food microbiology and safety. Tuesday evening's program features a poster session, reception, and opportunities to network with colleagues.
