

Dr. Ronald Weiss (Jan. 29, 1937 — Sept. 20, 2014)

Longtime FRI team member Dr. Ronald Weiss passed away on Sept. 20, 2014 following a valiant one-year battle with bone marrow cancer.

Dr. Weiss joined the Food Research Institute (FRI) as Research Program Manager in 1995. He acted as the liaison between FRI faculty and staff and the university scientific community and FRI's corporate sponsors, and was an invaluable contributor to the research, service, and education missions of the FRI program.

Within the Institute, Dr. Weiss was a colleague and friend to everyone, seeking to broaden their horizons by encouraging students and post-doctoral researchers to develop their strengths and talents and encouraging collaborations with other scientists and departments on campus to expand the research capabilities of FRI. He was a tireless and committed individual who contributed significantly to the FRI mission and program. Dr. Weiss retired from his position Sept. 4, 2007 after 12 years of dedicated service.
